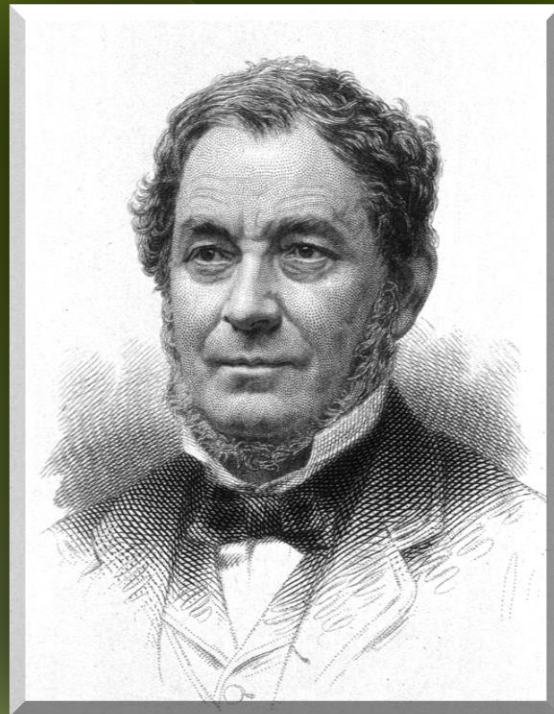


Robert Bunsen

Robert Bunsen was born in 1811. He was the youngest of four sons.





He was
a German chemist

Bunsen developed the
Bunsen burner



He attended school in
Holzminden and later studied
chemistry, mineralogy and
mathematics

During an experiment he almost died from arsenic poisoning and lost the sight of his right eye in an explosion with cacodyl

A Bunsen Burner provides a very hot and clean flame and is a very common laboratory equipment

Bunsen was one of the most
admired scientists of his
generation

He was a perfect gentleman
and devoted teacher

He died in Heidelberg at
the age of 88
